






U.S. LNG Update

- In 2018:
 - The U.S. exported ~1 (Tcf) of natural gas, up from 708 Bcf in 2017
 - The U.S. exported to 28 countries
 - Dominion's Cove
 Point LNG and
 Cheniere's Corpus
 Christi export facilities
 entered service





U.S. LNG Update

- A global supply race
 - US is the fastest growing in adding capacity
 - US to be 3rd largest supplier by 2019


 Since Feb. of 2016 US LNG cargoes have reached over 30 countries, and the list continues to grow




Cool, Clean Fuel

U.S. LNG Update

- LNG export terminals expected to reach 10 Bcf/d by the end of 2019
- U.S. is the fastest growing in terms of adding capacity







U.S. LNG in the Caribbean & Florida

- Demand for cleaner fuels like LNG is growing in the Caribbean, for both power and shipping
 - More than 20 Bcf of U.S.
 LNG has gone to the
 Dominican Republic and
 Jamaica since 2016
 - The growing number of LNG capable cruise ships, 31 in production, means opportunity for LNG bunkering in Florida







center for liquefied natural gas LNG Exports Projects in 2019

- On May 21st, Cameron LNG began the commissioning process
- Likely that 2 additional projects will begin exporting in 2019
 - Elba Island LNG
 - Freeport LNG
- Additional terminals are expected to make FID this year
 - Delfin LNG
 - Golden Pass LNG
 - Lake Charles LNG
 - Magnolia LNG
 - Driftwood LNG





DOE and U.S. LNG

- Recent Policy Statement on End Use Reporting strengthens the flexibility of U.S. LNG in the global market.
- Recent proposed rule making on filing of contracts and purchase agreements requires examination.





FERC and U.S. LNG

- FERC's Notice of Schedule Implementation
- A fully staffed FERC can better tackle permitting issues
- Impacts of a less than full commission on projects
